For other than Fire/Life/Safety Systems relating to Fire Alarms, and Smoke Detection as required by the NFPA or the California Fire code;

1) Do your Jurisdiction currently require permits for Low Voltage installations, such as Communications wiring, (Fiber Optic, Cat-5, Ether Net., Cu.Phone Lines. etc) within existing or new buildings?

2) Does your Jurisdiction currently require permits for Low Voltage installations, such as Landscaping wiring, (sprinkler controllers, lighting, etc)?

3) Does your Jurisdiction currently require permits for Low Voltage installations, for Security wiring, (burglar alarms, card readers, cameras, etc)?

If the answer is yes to any or all of the above, what procedures do you have in place, such as are they routed for review or are they processed over the counter? What do you require on the application and plans?
